SUBJECT: Harsco Rail Schools for the Year 2012

In accordance with Harsco Rail continuing training program, I am pleased to announce our year 2012 school schedule. This schedule also appears on our web site at www.harscorail.com under customer service.

Our schools will commence in January and continue through March. The cost for school will remain the same as last year, \$500.00 per student per course, payable in advance. Registration is mandatory and should be done as early as possible to assure yourself a seat. (See Registration Procedures). **(There will be a \$300.00 charge for No Shows that do not cancel 7 days prior to Class date)**

Schools listed for 2012 will be taught at Harsco Rail Columbia facility (Class Room A). Harsco Rail is located at 2401 Edmund Road, Cayce – West Columbia, SC (Highway 302, just past the entrance to the Columbia Metro Airport). **NOTE: Casual dress, NO shorts or open toe shoes. Plant tour will require steel toe shoes.**

Classes are held Monday through Thursday 8:00am – 5:00pm.

Please read the schedule and contents carefully to insure that you register for the proper class.

Registration Procedures

1. First, review and select the course you require. Note that some courses will be conducted only once this year.
2. Some courses require knowledge of working with blue prints and schematic reading.
3. The cost for school is \$500.00 per student per course. **NOTE: \$300.00 charge for No Shows that do not cancel 7 days prior to Class date.**

SUBJECT: Model 6700S OPERATORS & MECHANIC

COURSE DESCRIPTION: This course will cover in detail, the model 6700S Production / Switch tampers. This will include safety, setup, controls, calibration, troubleshooting and maintenance as applied to all aspects of track work.

A thorough discussion of the 6700 Jupiter machine as to applying it to the track, including lining curves with the Auto Curve Computer, and electrical, hydraulic, and pneumatic systems.

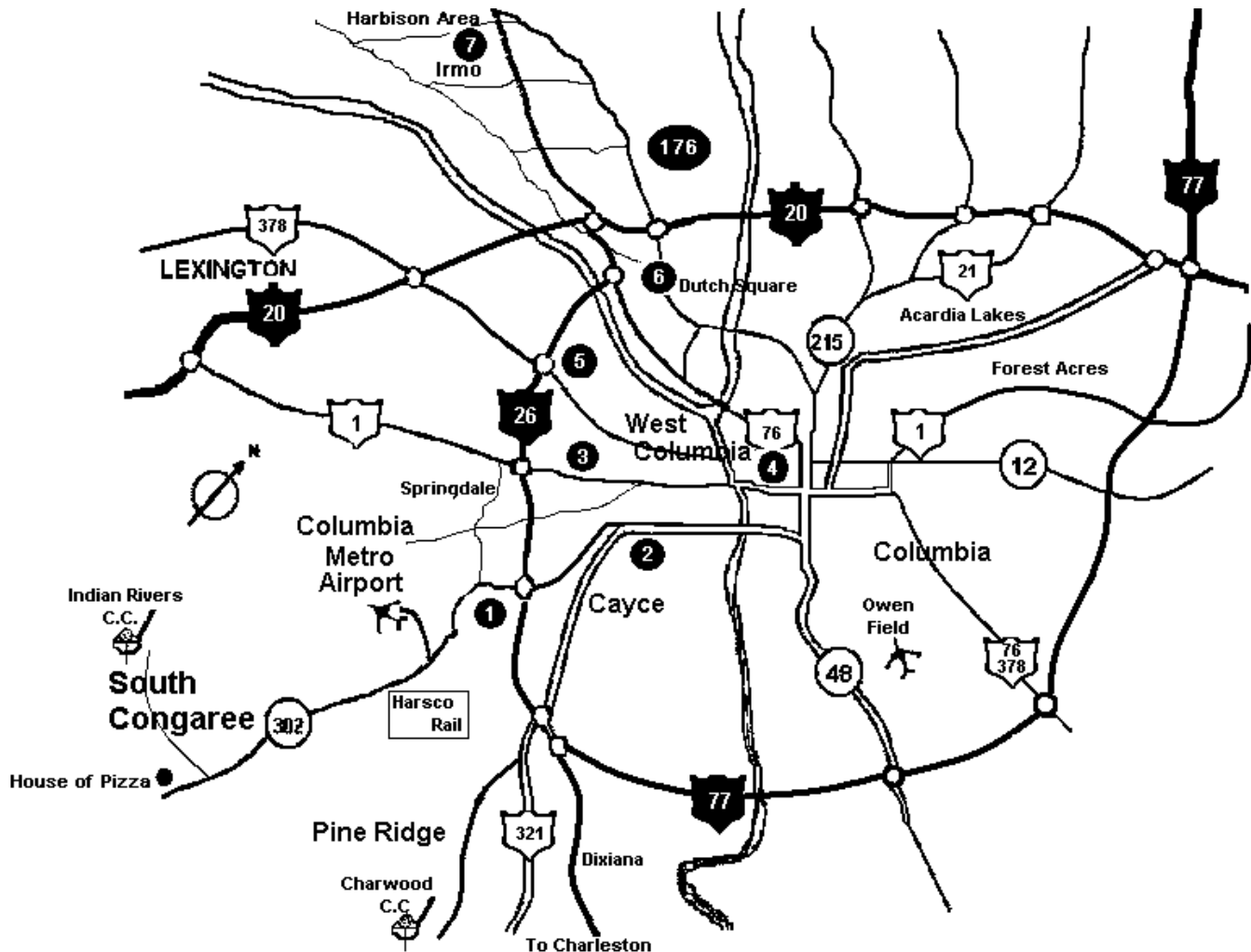
